

## NATIONAL COUNCIL FOR TEACHER EDUCATION NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 23rd July, 2010

F. No. 51-1/2009/NCTE (N&S).—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of Section 32 of the National Council for Teacher Education Act, 1993 (73 of 1993), the National Council for Teacher Education hereby makes the following regulations further to amend the National Council for Teacher Education (Recognition, Norms and Procedure) Regulations, 2009, namely:—

- (1) These Regulations may be called the National Council for Teacher Education (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Second Amendment Regulations, 2010.
  - (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- In the National Council for Teacher Education (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Regulations, 2009, (hereinafter referred to as the said regulations), in regulation 5, -
  - (a) in sub-regulation (4), for the words and figures "the 1" day of September till 31" day of October", the words and figures "the 1" day of August till 30" day of September" shall be substituted;

in sub-paragraph(II), in the Note, for the words "sixty-five years", the words "seventy years" shall be substituted.

In Appendix-7 to the said regulations,-

- in paragraph 3,
  - sub-paragraph (1), the following paragraph shall be inserted, namely:-

"Provided that the recognized institutions willing to upgrade their intake, shall be required to submit an application to the concerned Regional Committee of National Council for Teacher Education for the additional intake, and thereafter, the Regional Committee after assessing the instructional and infrastructural facilities under these Regulations if there is no restriction in the State of recognition of Bachelor of Physical Education Course sanction the additional intake; provided further that the intake capacity of 100 seats shall be approved only in those colleges which are established after the commencement of these Regulations and proposing a separate institution exclusively for physical education".

- for sub-paragraph (2), the following sub-paragraph shall be substituted, namely:-
- "(2) Eligibility

Bachelor's Degree with Physical Education as an elective subject with fifty per cent

Bachelor's Degree with Physical Education as an elective subject with forty-five per cent marks and participation in National or State or Inter-University competitions in sports or games or athletics recognized by Association of Indian Universities or Indian Olympic Association; or

Bachelor's Degree with forty-five per cent marks and having participated in National or State or Inter-University Sports or games or athletics; or

For deputed in-service candidates (i.e. trained physical education teachers / coaches) Graduation with forty-five per cent marks and at least three years of

Provided that the reservation of seats for SC or ST or OBC and other categories shall be as in accordance with the Central Government of State Government rules and a relaxation of five per cent in marks in eligibility qualification shall be allowed to candidates belonging to those categories";

in paragraph 4, in sub-paragraph (II), in the Note, for the figure and word "65 years", the words "seventy years" shall be substituted.

In Appendix-8 to the said regulations,-

in paragraph 3, in sub-paragraph (2), for clause (a), the following clause shall be

"Bachelor of Physical Education (B.P.Ed.) or Bachelor of Physical Education (BPE) or Bachelor of Science (B.Sc.) in Health and Physical Education and Degree in sports with at least fifty-five per cent marks.

- in paragraph 4, in sub-paragraph (II), in the Note, for the figure and word, "65 years the words "seventy years" shall be substituted.
- 8 . In:Appendix-10 to the said regulations, in paragraph 5, in sub-paragraph (2), in clause (a), for sub-clause (i), the following clause shall be substituted, namely:

(ii) Graduation or Post-Graduation Degree with fifty per cent marks: Provided that the requirement of fifty per cent marks shall not apply to persons appointed as teachers prior to the commencement of the National Council for Teacher Education (Regulations Norms and Procedure) Second Amendment Regulations, 2010."
